### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. ENTRY FEES \$7:50 per individual event and \$12:00 per relay event GST inclusive.
2. Age as at 29 October 2011
3. Entry times to be Long Course 50m.
4. All entries must be accompanied by a Meet Entry Fees Report (Team Manager) and Entry Fees.
5. Entries to be on disc or emailed and cheques payable to: AquaGym Swim Club Inc.

8. Entries **Close 5pm, 19 October 2011**. Any entries received after this date will be deemed to be late.
9. Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Director and only if there are free lanes. Late entries will not be eligible for prizes or points and will be swum as exhibition swims. \$10.00 late entry fee
10. **Girls 800 Freestyle will be limited to the top 8 - 16 entries received. Two heats will be run if enough entries are received. You will be advised accordingly**
11. **Boys 1500m Freestyle will be limited to the top 8 entries received.**
12. Unaccepted entries will be refunded. Entry fees for scratching will only be refunded if accompanied by a medical certificate within 48 hours.
13. No show or late scratching fine \$15.00
14. Individual event age groups are as follows;
  - 50m events: 9 & Under, 10/11yrs, 12/13yrs, 14/15yrs and 16&over.
  - 100m and 200m events: 11&under, 12/13yrs, 14/15yrs and 16&over.
  - 400m events: 13&under and 14&Over.
  - The 800m and 1500m Freestyle is swum as Open.
  - Skins : open
  - Relays: 13 & under, 14 & over
15. Electronic Timing will be used at this meet.
16. We shall endeavour to obtain the necessary number of officials but the number on pool side maybe more or less than the stated number required by Swim NZ.

### **RULES OF THE MEET**

1. All events will be conducted under the regulations of SNZ and FINA Rules except where local rules apply.
2. Swimmers with a disability may compete at this Meet and shall compete under IPC rules. Swimmers must present their classification card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the Meet.
3. All events will be run as **Timed Finals**, multi age group & single gender. Results will be separated into gender and age groups for final placing and prizes.
4. Heats will be seeded slowest to fastest.
5. Swimmers shall not climb over the touch pads at any time when leaving the pool and shall move under the lane ropes.
6. Relay names, in the order of swimming must be in the recorder's hands **40 minutes before** the start time of the session in which they are to be swum.
7. At the beginning of each race when the whistle is blown there is to be silence and no movement on poolside or from the swimmers of the previous event or heat in the water.
8. Protests shall be as per SNZ Regulation 3.3, the fee shall be \$50.00.



## PRIZES

**Medals** will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each individual event.

**Towels** will be presented for the 1<sup>st</sup> placing in relay events with ribbons for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**Skins Events:** 1<sup>st</sup> \$100 Cash 2<sup>nd</sup> \$50 Cash Male and Female

**Top A Club (15 or more swimmers) and B Club (14 or less swimmers) Trophies**

## RELAYS

1. All relay swimmers must enter and compete in an individual event at this meet to be eligible to swim in relay events.
2. "B" clubs may combine teams to make up relay teams.
3. Ages: 13&under, 14&over

## SCRATCHING RULE

1. Entrants wishing to withdraw from events shall do so in writing signed by the swimmer's Coach/Team Manager and lodged with the recorder as detailed below.
2. Scratchings as per SNZ rules. **A \$15.00 fine will apply for late or non-scratching from events.**
3. Scratching for session 1 : to be with meet organiser by 5pm 28 October 2011
4. Scratching for session 2 close 15 minutes after the end of session 1.
5. Swimmers will be deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to the marshall at the appropriate time prior to their heat.
6. Reseeding will be done at the discretion of the meet director.

## MARSHALLING

1. All swimmers must be marshalled as all events will start promptly, and competitors must be ready when called, otherwise the event will be started without them.
2. Swimmers to be in the marshalling area four (4) races before their event in 200m and less races and at least two (2) races before 400m and 800m events.
3. If this is not adhered to swimmers may be disqualified from their event and fined.

## WARM UP PROCEDURE

1. Warm-up Procedure as per **SCWC/ Swim Otago WARM – UP PROCEDURE.**
2. Swimmers are requested not to sit on the lane ropes, or climb over or sit on the touch pads.

## Timekeepers and officials

Neptune Swim Club and Swim Otago have kindly offered to help with Control room and some top officials but this leaves the job of **timekeeping and IOTs**. We respectfully ask for help in this matter and request each club sending swimmers provide some assistance. Our promise is really yummy food and the opportunity to watch your child up close. ## **FREESTYLE SKINS EVENT**

1. Qualifying race: events 31 and 32 – 50m freestyle
2. Age group is open for male and female
3. Top 16 from each event will race for top 8
4. Top 8 will race to find top 4
5. Top 4 to find top 2
6. Final is between last two swimmers
7. A skins with a twist – there is no diving to start – a push start is required
8. Push start – at least one hand and one foot must be on the wall at the start
9. No swim backs
10. Push starts allow us to use electronic timing
11. Prizes: \$100.00 for winner in each gender, \$50.00 for second in each gender
